

## INTERNATIONAL EARLY YEARS CURRICULUM (IEYC)

'Learning at VIVEK SUMMIT SCHOOL inspires us to discover, explore and use our knowledge, skills and attitudes to develop ourselves as citizens of tomorrow.'

The International Early Years Curriculum (IEYC) is a new research-based curriculum recognising global best practice in early childhood education and the developmental needs upto 5 year olds.

It supports key areas of learning through holistic enquiry and play-based approaches that cover all curriculum areas including personal, social and emotional development.

### How is the IEYC taught?

The International Early Years Curriculum (IEYC) has a framework for teaching and learning. This framework comes in the form of learning strands. Each Strand provides descriptions of what children will experience and learn about, through contextualized 'Explore and Express' activities.

All of the learning that takes place through the strands is connected via an IEYC unit of learning or 'theme'. Each theme follows a process of learning.



# FOUR LEARNING STRANDS

The Academic Dimension of learning and development has a set of four Learning Strands that the IEYC regards as developmentally appropriate for learners aged upto 5 year olds. Each of the four Learning Strands describes what children will experience and learn about through contextualised activities woven into the IEYC thematic units of learning.

### They are:

Independence and Interdependence: This strand focuses on developing positive attributes and self-awareness social confidence and competence, and emotional awareness and regulation.

Communicating: This strand focuses on developing a broad range of communication skills, including language development, early literacy, early mathematics, Information and Communication Technology (ICT) and computing, expressive arts and creativity.

**Enquiring:** This strand focuses on developing the skills of enquiry through experiences that nurture knowledge and understanding of people and the world around them.

Healthy Living and Physical Well-Being: This strands focuses on developing a positive attitude to health, selfcare and physical activity.

### LEARNING STRUCTURE

The Entry Point launches each new IEYC unit and is planned to enable children to explore new experiences in a way that sparks interest and curiosity, prompting recall of previous learning and generating excitement for the new learning to come.

Capturing Curiosity allows learners to share what they are curious to learn and the unit is adapted to enhance these opportunities.

Enable the Environment develops relevant indoor and outdoor learning spaces to create the positive climate for enquiry and learning to take place.

The Big Picture provides learners with an overview of each unit of learning and prepares them for a new learning experience.

Explore & Express provides children with opportunities to engage in activities that have been holistically designed around the Learning Strands.

The Exit Point ends every IEYC unit. It brings learners together to reflect, share and celebrate what they have learnt together with their parents and guardians.

# INTERNATIONAL PRIMARY CURRICULUM (IPC)

The International Primary Curriculum (IPC) is an international, modern, comprehensive and future oriented curriculum programme for children aged from 5 to 12 years.

The IPC extends knowledge, skills and understanding, develops personal attributes and supports an international perspective in a way that responds to revised ideas about learning.

### What is the IPC?

### The IPC:

- is thematic
- includes personal development
- develops international mindedness
- investigates global themes and heritage
- includes Assessment For Learning (AFL)

## THE IPC LEARNING GOALS

The IPC Learning Goals are the foundation of the IPC. The IPC Learning Goals define what children are expected to know, what they should be able to do, and the understandings they will develop in their academic, personal and international learning.

The IPC Learning Goals are defined in each age phase: Milepost 1 (ages 5-7 years), Milepost 2 (ages 7-9 years) and Milepost 3 (ages 9-12 years).

These learning goals guide learning and teaching and help to focus assessment. We believe that the IPC Learning Goals are equal to or exceed those of any curriculum in the world.

We have three types of Learning Goals:

#### Subject Learning Goals

The subject goals cover the knowledge, skills and understanding that children should learn in Science, History, Geography, ICT, Technology, Music, Art, PE, Society and International. These subjects are built into the different thematic units of work, where they work independently yet interdependently with each other so that children can talk about their learning through multiple perspectives.

#### Personal Learning Goals

The personal goals refer to those individual qualities and dispositions we believe children will find essential in the 21st century. There are eight IPC personal goals: enquiry, resilience, morality, communication, thoughtfulness, co-operation, respect and adaptability.

Opportunities to experience and practice these very specific dispositions are built into the learning tasks within each unit of work.

#### International Learning Goals

The IPC is unique in defining learning goals that help young children begin the move towards an increasingly sophisticated national, international, global and intercultural perspective. Each IPC unit has embedded within it, learning-focused activities that help children gain an increasing sense of themselves, their community and the world around them, whilst developing the capacity to take action and make a difference.

### IPC UNIT STRUCTURE

Each IPC unit follows the same structure. At the beginning of all IPC units there is an 'Entry Point' followed by a 'Knowledge Harvest'. Once these two tasks have taken place, the children will carry out their learning tasks subject by subject to achieve, or develop towards achieving, their learning goals.

At the end of some IPC units there is an 'Exit Point'.

**Entry Point:** An activity at the beginning of each IPC unit which provides an exciting introduction to the work that is to follow.

Knowledge Harvest: A specific activity which takes place in the early stages of each unit. This activity provides an opportunity for children to reveal what they already know about the theme they are studying and for their teacher to build on that knowledge.

Subject Learning Goals: These are the goals of achievement for the students learning within the IPC subjects.

Personal Goals: These are the goals which promote and develop the students personal qualities of; enquiry; adaptability; resilience; morality; communication; thoughtfulness; cooperation and respect. By their nature, the personal goals are not age-specific.

International Goals: These are the goals for students learning, development and understanding on Internationalism.

Learning Tasks: The students learning tasks which are delivered with a variety of learning styles in mind; these will include enquiry based research tasks, recording tasks and international tasks.

Exit Point: The Exit Point is an excellent chance to engage with parents and guardians to involve them in celebrating the learning that has been achieved.




We have introduced Foundation Education in Technology at an early age, in order to groom our students to be tech savvy and face the technologies world boldly.

Meal times are semi – formal affairs and allows the teacher to inculcate good eating habits and table etiquettes in the children.






