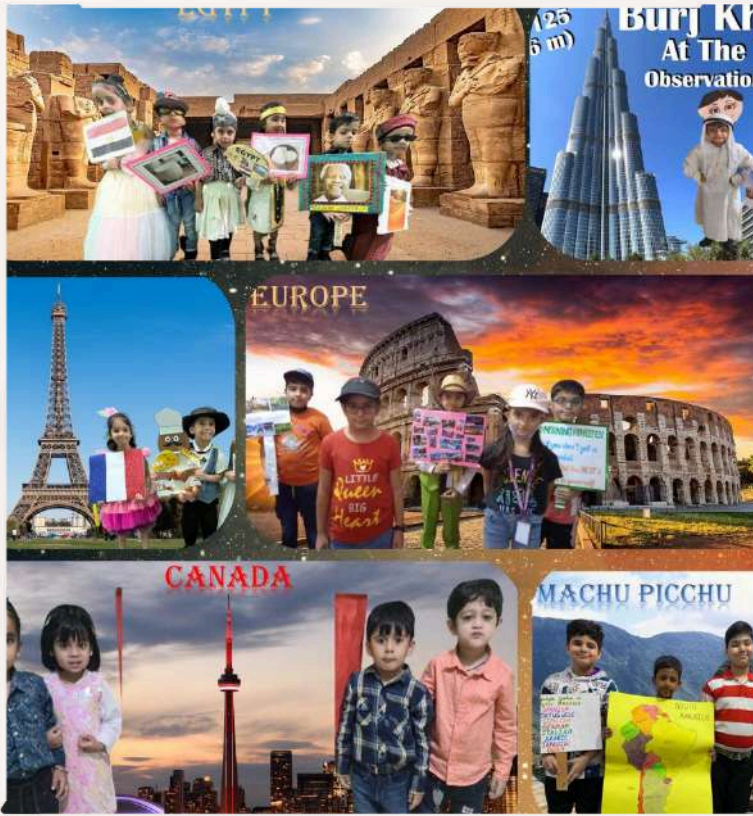
WORLD TOURISM DAY

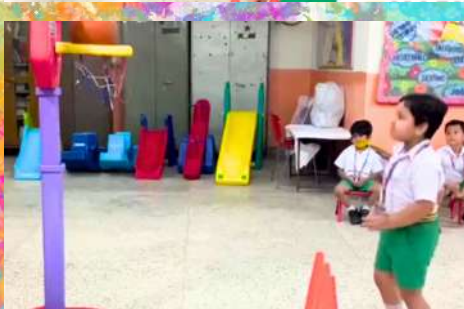


SPORTS DAY

Geeta upadesh an enactment of the scene from the battle ground of Mahabharata was showcased followed by captivating skits, story narrations, dances & songs etc.

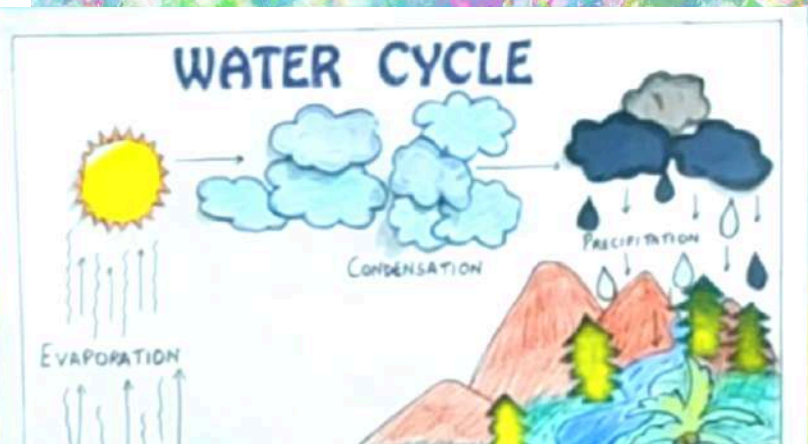
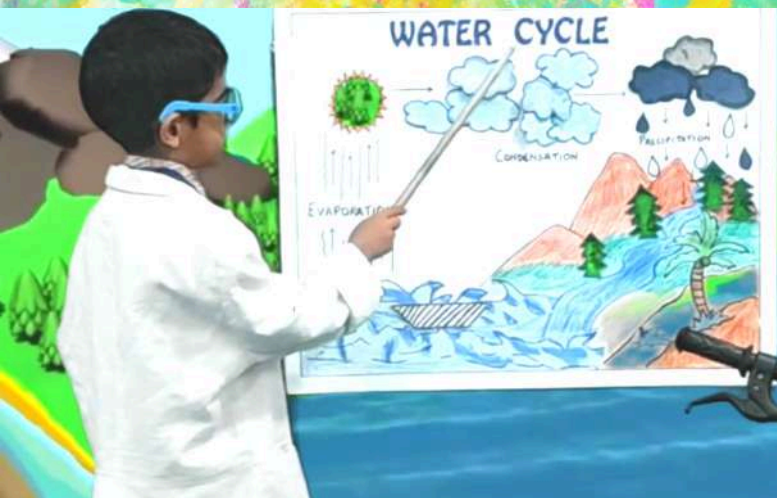
